2011 ALL-AROUND STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

Since 1986, the *Kiwanis Club of Clovis* has provided scholarship support to the students of the Clovis Unified School District. Continuing its service to the students of the district, a one thousand five hundred dollar (\$1,500) scholarship will again be awarded at ***each*** high school to a graduating senior who is judged to be the most outstanding all-around student of their graduating class.

The scholarship funds will be deposited in an account at an educational institution named by the recipient. The college or university will draw directly from the fund as needed to pay for tuition, fees, room and board, or books as those expenses are incurred by the recipient. The money awarded may not be used for any other purpose.

Each application will be reviewed by a committee composed of members of the *Kiwanis Club of Clovis*. The committee will select applicants for interviews. All information provided in this application will remain confidential.

ELIGIBILITY

Any *graduating senior* at Buchanan, Clovis, Clovis East, Clovis North and Clovis West High Schools is eligible to apply for this scholarship.

CRITERIA

The committee's decision will be based on its assessment of a combination of the applicant's, academic and extracurricular achievement; involvement in school and community activities; character, and maturity.

APPLICATION

This application has been designed by the Kiwanis Club of Clovis to allow each committee an opportunity to fully evaluate each applicant for the award. Applicants must use this form as presented.

This form is in a .pdf format that allows you to complete the form on the web and print out and submit the form. You will not be able to download the form. All applications must be **typewritten**. Handwritten forms **will not** be accepted.

Applicants must fill out this form as completely as possible. In the **Student Activities** portion, applicants are encouraged to prioritize their activities by listing those activities with the most years of participation first in each category. Activities that do not indicate years of participation will be discounted.

Any addendum other than the required essay and the required copy of the applicant's academic transcript provided through the counselor as noted below **will not be considered** in order to provide for an impartial review of all applicants. In order to be considered, applications must be delivered to the office of the academic counselor on or before 5 p.m. on April 13, 2011.

After completing this application, please attach, **in type-written form**, a two hundred fifty to five hundred (250-500) word essay on your personal goals after you complete your education.
